## 1. Attacking Your Own Team?

In the book of Judges 7:15-22 we can read how Gideon's army used unconventional tactics with trumpets, jars, and torches to surprise and defeat the Midianites by having them attack each other.

The enemy has been using this same tactic to confuse us and distracted us from our true identity as the people who love each other.

John 13:34-35 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

### 2. Unity of the Spirit

**Ephesians 4:2-3** "Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. 3 Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."
