Living Unto The Lord

Romans 14:7-8 James Brown

1. All things for Him

Romans 14:7-8 For none of us lives to himself, and none of us dies to himself. For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's.

We're not just doing things for God when we're at church, everything we do is for Him! You might not think that just going about your day-to-day life is significant. But it's not what you're doing, it's who you're doing it for that is important. We live to the Lord. We all have a part to play in the kingdom of God.

2. Faithful in the little things

Matthew 25:23 His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'

When we do little things to help each other, it's as if we're doing them directly unto Jesus. Because when we hurt, He hurts. And when we're happy, He's happy. We should remember that everything we do, we're doing for Jesus. God always rewards us when we do little things to help each other instead of little things to hurt each other.

3. God lifts up the humble

James 4:10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.

David was a shepherd before he was a king. Joseph was a caretaker before he was prime minister. God doesn't lift up people who think they are special or important. He exalts those who think of God and other people first. That's what it means to humble yourself before the Lord.
