Hebrews 10:24-25

1. The importance of encouragement

Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

God works through other people to strengthen and encourage us. He never meant for us to be alone. We need each other.

2. Powerful encouragement

Proverbs 12:25 Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad.

We have power in our words to lift other people up. Love focuses on the good in people over criticizing their flaws. A little bit of encouragement can change someone's whole outlook and motivation in life.

3. Encouragement from experience

2 Corinthains 1:4 who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.

After we have been strengthened and encouraged by God, He then uses us to strengthen and encourage other people. Encouragement means much more when it is coming from someone who has experienced what you are going through.
