Don't Give Up

Galatians 6:9

Galatians 6:9 “And let us not grow weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.”

1. Bringing Glory to God

Colossians 3:23-24 *Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.”*

Shift your focus back to honoring God, and giving glory to God in whatever you do.

2. Giving Joyfully

2 Corinthians 9:7 “Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”

Whatever you do—whether it’s at work, school, helping at church, or anything else—do it with joy, knowing that your work is an act of worship, not something you do to earn God’s approval. Always remember: God already loves you.

3. Trusting in God’s Timing and Promises

1 Corinthians 15:58 *Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.”*

When you feel weary, trust God’s promise that your labor will bear fruit in His perfect timing.

Remember:

- Serve God, not people, and not for appearances.
- Work as an act of worship, not obligation.
- Trust in God’s promise.
- Ask God to renew your strength and refocus your heart on serving Him.

Isaiah 40:31: *But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.”*
